Map to Tangier Restaurant 532 West Market Street Akron, Ohio

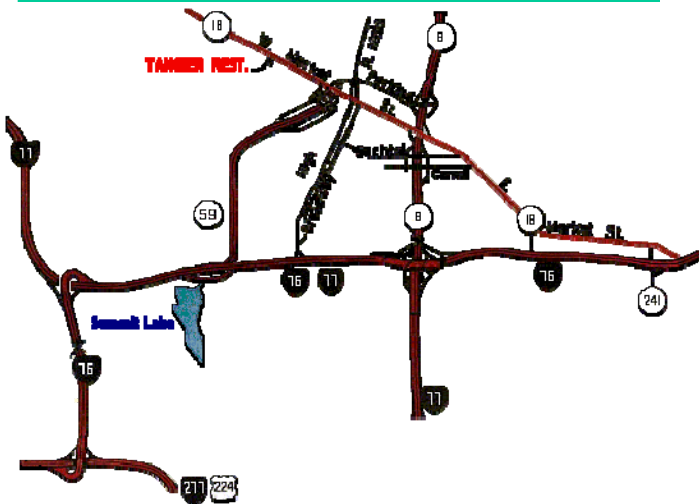
